An alumna of KMC Manipal, she completed her MS- General Surgery from Medical College, Kolkata , HBNI Fellowship from TMH Mumbai , and FEBS -EBSQ (Breast Surgery). She independently established the Department of Breast Surgery at Narayana Superspeciality Hospital, Howrah, launching its first 1-year Breast Fellowship.

Her technical expertise spans advanced oncoplastic rearrangements, chest wall perforator flaps, and implant-based breast reconstruction. She is also actively venturing into robotic breast surgery. Dr. Choudhary is a published author , an invited book chapter contributor , a peer-reviewer for reputed oncology journals, co-investigator in Phase III global clinical trials and a regular speaker and workshop trainer at national and international forums.
